 Vale wide service for all residents who meet the eligibility criteria

Genesis 2 Cymru Wales

- Genesis aims to overcome barriers encountered by people wanting to return to work or training, these could be low self esteem/confidence, childcare or transport issues.
- These would be addressed through quality assistance, enabling economically inactive people to access training, education and employment.

What Genesis Offers

- 1 to 1 support, advice and guidance
- Confidence building Through a variety of courses i.e. STEPS or Genesis Coffee & Confidence Sessions (Barry and St Athan)
- Practical help to access training, education and/or childcare costs (where eligible).

Who Genesis 2 Can Help

- Must be over 16 years of age
- Priority will be given to lone parents:
 young people not in employment,
 education or training: people with health
 problems or a disability: older participants
 and members of black and ethnic minority
 communities:
- Working less than 16 hours per week

Where

All areas of the Vale of Glamorgan

 Priority is given to residents of: Buttrills, Cadoc, Castleland, Court, Gibbonsdown, Llantwit Major and St Athan areas.

 Genesis staff can meet prospective participants in their locality.
