What is The Index?

The Index is Cardiff and the Vale of Glamorgan's voluntary register of children and young people with disabilities or additional needs.

The Index aims to provide information to:

- **Families** keeping families up to date with services, support and activities across Cardiff and the Vale of Glamorgan. It also provides a point of contact for families to discuss their needs.
- **Professionals** keeping professionals up to date with the needs of children and young people with disabilities or additional needs, in order to plan services and improve access to services and support.
- Organisations promoting existing services and support.



Who can sign up to The Index?

In order to be on The Index, a child or young person must:

- Be aged 0 18 years.
- Have a diagnosed disability, be in the process of diagnosis or have confirmed ongoing additional needs.

Why sign up to The Index?

Once signed up to The Index, you will receive:

- **The Index** the newsletter which is sent out every 3 months, packed full of information about services, support and activities in Cardiff and the Vale of Glamorgan.
- The Index eNews regular emails providing information about any activities and events which may be happening between issues of the newsletter.

Signing up will also mean that you help to influence the type of services being offered and developed.



What information do we need?

- Basic information e.g. name, date of birth, contact details, school.
- Details about any disabilities or additional needs.
- Details about services and support you already access/receive.
- Details of any specific information or support which you need.

Promise of confidentiality

- Information will be held confidentially on a secure system within each Family Information Service.
- Personal details will not be shared unless consent is given, or required to in law.
- All data or information requests will be strictly administered and monitored by the Disability Index Officer/Administrator under the Data Protection Act 1998.
- Anonymised statistical information will only be available to agencies responsible for planning / providing services for children and young people with disabilities or additional needs.
