General Facts Cardiff and the Vale


- Population fastest growing in Wales x 2
- Biggest increase in birthrate x 3
- Ageing population over 85s increasing faster than rest of population
- 103k most deprived in Wales
- Care for 'city' based groups with complex needs
 - Sharp rise in asylum seekers
 - Complexity of homelessness needs
- Our funding allocation lowest in Wales



Challenges

- UHW not just another district hospital- specialist centre
- 60% of medical equipment and 50 % of IT out of life
- 15% estate in critical need of attention
- Pick up complex services from other UHBneurology, cancer
- Recent demand for Out of Hours services
 outstripped capacity
