<p>ValeInfoBase – Iwan Thomas/Sally Pritchard (Local Government Data Unit)</p> <p>Iwan gave a description on how the new system will be used.</p> <p>The system will bring data together from across all local authorities within Wales. This will be made easy to access for partners and members of the public. Data comparisons will initially be made using towns and villages, clusters, wards and strategic areas.</p> <p>Iwan proposed that the LSB insight work with the council, so that it can be used as a tool in order to monitor the different priorities in place in the vale.</p> <p>The next step for the system is to rebrand and promote in the next month. The public will be able to access the system and see progress of the partnership.</p> <p>Iwan requested member look at the system as it is already available online and comment on any improvements and amendments that could be made. Mike to send out link.</p> <p>It was agreed that the group would look at the Flintshire tool and how it is used when the Infobase presentation is given at the next meeting.</p> <p>The nine priority (There are ten priorities, but for purpose of the website two have been combined) outcomes will match the data. The priority outcomes will be updated accordingly to show what progress has been made. This will also show why the nine priorities have been chosen and should help when the plan is written.</p> <p>There is a five day window for the data unit to align new data across partnerships once released by WG.</p> <p>It was suggested that that some of the terminology should be simplify for members of the public who wish to access the website. The public will also be able to use their postcode to find out which ward, etc they come under.</p>	<p>MJ</p>

<p>It was also suggested that area profiles should be made interactive - Gethin will look into.</p> <p>The site is being refreshed which should take about four weeks to complete as it has not been modified since it first started two years ago.</p>	
<p>Business Intelligence Group Development Event – Local Government.</p> <p>The development event will take place on the 28th February 2013 at the Barry Memorial hall, in the Glamorgan Suit. The agenda for the day is to be sent out by Duncan. A diary marker has already been sent.</p> <p>The questionnaires sent by partners have helped to give areas for discussion. The morning will include presentations and workshops, which will hopefully help to identify the correct Vale of Glamorgan Council Officers involved in consultation. This will help us to align consultations and information sharing.</p> <p>It was agreed that health and education would produce a ten to fifteen minute presentation showing the key data they are using to see if it is of use to others.</p> <p>Consultation events within The Vale of Glamorgan Council are starting to be recorded in the hope of rolling out to the LSB, if successful internally. It will also be put on to the vale website for the public to view.</p> <p>It was suggested that the chair of the LSB should be invited to present at the event.
