40 o swyddi wedi'u hachub a chyda'r lefel braesept isaf yng Nghymru o hyd

Mae Comisiynydd yr Heddlu a Throseddau De Cymru, Alun Michael, wedi pennu cyllideb yr heddlu ar gyfer 2013-14 fel £258.6 miliwn.

Mae elfen yr heddlu o'r dreth gyngor wedi cynyddu 3c y dydd ar gyfer 2013-14. Mae hyn gyfwerth ag £11.86 (7%) yn ychwanegol y flwyddyn ar gyfer cartref Band D, sy'n gyfanswm o £181.28 y flwyddyn ar gyfer gwasanaeth yr heddlu 24 awr y dydd, 7 diwrnod yr wythnos.

Mae'r cynnydd, sy'n llai nag 1% o gyfanswm bil y dreth gyngor yn sicrhau swyddi 40 o Swyddogion Cymorth Cymunedol yr Heddlu, yn ogystal â chreu cronfa bartneriaeth gwerth £1 filiwn, sydd i'w defnyddio i leihau nifer y troseddau.

Mae'r penderfyniad i gynyddu'r praesept wedi bod yn angenrheidiol oherwydd yr hyn y mae Mr Michael yn ei ddisgrifio fel effaith "ddidostur" toriadau'r llywodraeth, gan gynnwys gostyngiad o £2.8 miliwn yn 2013-14 a lefel hanesyddol isel praesept De Cymru.

Eleni, mae'r Llywodraeth wedi cyfuno'r Gronfa Plismona yn y Gymdogaeth, a oedd yn cael ei diogelu'n flaenorol ac sy'n talu am Swyddogion Cymorth Cymunedol yr Heddlu, gyda'r prif grant - ond drwy wneud hynny mae wedi rhoi rhy ychydig i Dde Cymru o swm sydd gyfwerth â 40 o Swyddogion Cymorth Cymunedol yr Heddlu.

40 Jobs saved and still lowest precept level in Wales

The Police and Crime Commissioner for South Wales, Alun Michael, has set the police budget for 2013-14 as £258.6million.

The police element of council tax has increased by 3p per day for 2013-14. This is equal to £11.86 (7%) extra per year for a Band D household, totalling £181.28 per year for a 24 hour, seven days a week police service.

The increase, which is less than 1% on the total council tax bill secures the jobs of 40 Police Community Support Officers, as well as creating a £1million partnership fund, to be used to drive down crime.

The decision to increase the precept has been made necessary because of what Mr Michael described as the "draconian" impact of government cuts including a £2.8 million reduction in 2013-14 and the historically low level of South Wales precept.

This year, the Government has combined the previously protected Neighbourhood Policing Fund, which pays for Police Community Support Officers, into the main grant - but in doing so has short-changed South Wales by a sum equal to 40 Police Community Support Officers.

Dywedodd Mr Michael: "Sylweddolaf fod unrhyw gynnydd yn y dreth gyngor yn anodd i gyhoedd De Cymru. Fodd bynnag, rwyf wedi gorffod gwneud y penderfyniad anodd er mwyn gweithredu'n gyfrifol a diogelu a chynnal gwasanaeth yr heddlu o ansawdd mewn ffordd effeithiol. Mae'r gyllideb hon yn ein caniatáu i barhau i roi pwysau ar leihau nifer y troseddau ac anhrefn, hyd yn oed mewn adegau mor anodd."

Mr Michael said: "I realise that any increase in council tax is difficult for the public in South Wales. However, I have had to make the difficult decision in order to act responsibly and effectively protect and maintain a high quality police service. This budget allows us to continue the downward pressure on crime and disorder, even in such difficult times."

£30.3M yw cyllideb y rhaglen Gyfalaf ar gyfer 2013-14. Mae cyllid ar gael o grant cyfalaf y Swyddfa Gartref o £2.3M a benthycu allanol o £1.7M, sy'n golygu bod angen cyllid mewnol neu gronfeydd cyfalaf o £26.3M. Ym mis Mawrth 2012, £7.3M oedd swm y cronfeydd cyffredinol. Ym mis Mawrth 2013, bydd swm y cronfeydd yn £8.1M amcangyfrifedig. £8.4M yw'r lefel ofynnol a argymhellir.

The Capital programme budget for 2013-14 is £30.3M. Funding is made available from Home Office capital grant £2.3M and external borrowing of £1.7M, meaning internal financing or capital reserves of £26.3M are required. As at March 2012, the general reserves held was £7.3M. As at March 2013, the reserve shall be an estimated £8.1M. The recommended minimum level should be £8.4m.
