### Cyflawni Mwy Gyda'n Gilydd Tuag At Dde Cymru Mwy Diogel

De Cymru yw un o'r ardaloedd mwyaf diogel i fyw a gweithio yn y DU ond gwna'r pwysau dwys ar blismona a gwasanaethau eraill hi'n ofynnol i ystyried yn ofalus iawn pa lefel o dreth cyngor sy'n angenreidiol er mwyn cynorthwyo ein cymunedau a mynd i'r afael â bygythiadau trosedd sy'n dod i'r amlwg.

Y canlyniad yw cynnydd ym mhraeseyt yr Heddlu - ond bydd deiliad tai De Cymru yn parhau i dalu'r hyn sydd ymysg y costau plismona isaf yng Nghymru gyda chynnydd o £10.39 y flwyddyn (2.8c y diwrnod) ar gyfer eiddo Band D. Mae Comisiynydd yr Heddlu a Throseddu De Cymru wedi penu'r dreth gyngor ar £218.24, gan gyfrannu £105m tuag at gyllideb o £262.8m ar gyfer gwasanaeth heddlu 24 awr, saith diwrnod yr wythnos.

Roedd setliad yr heddlu yn waeth na'r disgwyl. Cafodd £2.2m ychwanegol ei dorri o Grant yr Heddlu. Ac o ganlyniad uniongyrchol i bolisi'r Llywodraeth, mae'n rhaid i ni ddod o hyd i £1m ar gyfer y Lefi Prentisiaeth newydd. Mae'r Llywodraeth hefyd wedi torri £2.1m oddi ar ein grant cyfalaf ers 2011 ac hefyd mae effaith chwyddiant. Bydd y praesept ond yn mynd i'r afael â rhan o'r bwllch hwn, ynghyd ag arbedion effeithlonrwydd eleni o £3.1m ar ben y £45m o arbedion a gyflawnwyd yn llwyddianus ers 2010.

Nod Cynllun yr Heddlu a Gostwng Troseddu 2017-21 yw diogelu ein pobl a gweithio hyd yn oed yn agosach gyda phobl leol. Lluniwyd y Cynllun drwy gydweithio agos â'r Prif Gwnstabl ac mae'n nodi ein gweledigaeth ar gyfer plismona yn Ne Cymru. Mae'n rhoi pwyslais clir ar ymyriadau cynnar a gweithredu prydlon, cadarnhaol. Mae'r Cynllun yn nodi sut y bydd Heddlu De Cymru yn ymateb i fygwythiadau cynyddol megis trosedd ar-lein a cham-fanteisio'n rhywiol ar blant.

Er gwaethaf yr heriau ariannol, rydym wedi gwella perfformiad yn gyson wrth i ni weithio tuag gael ein hystyried fel yr heddlu gorau am wrando ar anghenion ein holl gymunedau yn Ne Cymru a'u deall. Cafodd ein perfformiad ei gydnabod yn allanol:

- Y Swyddfa Gartref – "Gan De Cymru oedd y presenoldeb gorau ar draws y 43 o gwnstabliaethau."
- ACEM - Rhagorol am "ddeall ein cymunedau ac ymgysylltu â hwy" ac am "ddeall y galw presennol a'r galw yn y dyfodol."
- Y gorau drwy'r wlad am gyfraddau canlyniadau cadarnhaol ar gyfer Trais gydag Anaf a Bwrglera Domestig.

### Achieving More Together Towards a Safer South Wales

South Wales is one of the safest areas to live and work in the UK but the intense pressure on policing and other services makes it necessary to give very careful consideration to the level of council tax needed to support our communities and address emerging crime threats.

The result is an increase in the Police precept - but householders in South Wales will continue to pay amongst the lowest costs for policing in Wales with an increase of £10.39 a year (2.8p a day) for Band D properties. The Police and Crime Commissioner for South Wales, has set the council tax at £218.24, contributing £105m towards the £262.8m budget for a 24 hour, seven day a week police service.

The police settlement was worse than we had feared. Police Grant has been cut by a further £2.2m. And as a direct result of Government policy, we have to find £1m for the new Apprenticeship Levy. The Government has also cut our capital grant by £2.1m since 2011 and there is the impact of inflation. The precept will address only part of this gap, along with efficiency savings this year of £3.1m on top of the £45m of savings successfully delivered since 2010.

The Police and Crime Reduction Plan 2017-21 is about protecting our people and working ever more closely with local communities. The Plan has been produced in close co-operation with the Chief Constable and sets out our vision for policing in South Wales. It provides a clear emphasis on early intervention and prompt, positive action. The Plan sets out how South Wales Police will respond to growing threats such as internet enabled crime and child sexual exploitation.

Despite the financial challenges, we have consistently improved performance as we work towards being the best at listening and understanding the needs of all our communities in South Wales. Our performance has been externally recognised:

- The Home Office - "South Wales had the best visibility across 43 constabularies."
- HMIC - Outstanding for "understanding and engaging with our communities" and "understanding of current and future demand."
- 1st in the country for positive outcome rates for Violence with Injury and Domestic Burglary.

The Capital programme budget for 2017-18 is £23.3m. Funding is made available from Home Office capital grant £1m and external borrowing of £1.7m, meaning internal financing or capital reserves of £20.6m are required.
