ALPS Training for Governors

ALPS delivers training sessions aimed at governors of schools with sixth forms and colleges in local authorities across England, Wales and Northern Ireland. Their training will focus on the importance for governors of ensuring that sixth form students make good or outstanding progress.

It gives them a good understanding of ALPS – the Advanced Level Performance System – both in terms of using our national benchmarks to set aspirational targets for teachers and students and in terms of using ALPS reports at the start of each academic year to evaluate student progress and school and subject performance.

To ensure the session is interactive it involves a case study using selected pages from an example ALPS A level and AS level reports.

Governors are also welcome to bring copies of their own school or college's reports.

- recognise the importance of training and the need to develop their skills and those of the governor body and take advantage of other training opportunities available to them.

The Central South Consortium recognises the importance of governors and the key role that they play in supporting and challenging their schools.

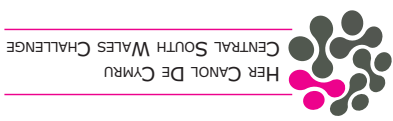
