Skills Offered	The Trust runs a range of innovative practical programmes that engage and inspire young people. The programmes provide young disadvantaged people with an opportunity to learn new skills in a variety of different trades. The courses aim to inspire those living in deprived areas about career choices in environment. We aim to provide a sense of direction and motivation with employment becoming a more achievable goal.
	Our Practical Community Projects provide local residents with the opportunity to transform their local environment and community spaces through real construction projects. These projects are an excellent way for young people to engage with their community and receive training at the same time.
	The Mobile Classroom programme provides an excellent opportunity for young people aged 14-30, to try different construction trades in a community or training space in their local area. The Classroom is a vehicle which delivers all the necessary tools and materials for our trainers to provide accessible introductory 'pop-up' training programmes in hard to reach communities. We can deliver OCNs at Entry Level 3 and Level One across all the trades, however the course we are recommending at present is OCNLR Level 1 Award in Health and Safety in a Construction Environment (QCF) which Construction Youth Trust runs with OCN London. This qualification is suitable for learners aged 16+ who require development of their knowledge and understanding of health and safety in a construction environment and for individuals who wish to gain the CSCS Green Card, or for current Construction Site Operative cardholders seeking renewal. Learners will gain the knowledge and skills to work safely and efficiently in their workplace. The OCNLR Level 1 Award in Health and Safety in a Construction Site Operative cardholders are seeking renewal. 	Both programmes introduces the sector to young people who may not have been exposed to work-related skills training before, and give them a unique chance to find out about the wide range of job opportunities available within the industry.
