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Learning 4 Life is a pre-vocational programme designed to meet the needs of young people who are not ready to engage in full time mainstream education or employment. Learners attend up to two days a week following an individual learning plan to ensure their needs are fully met. This includes essential skills, life skills (including independent living skills), employability skills and social skills. Learners take part in a range of activities including individual work and workshops in the classroom. They are also encouraged to take part in mock interviews, work tasters, employer site visits and volunteering opportunities to further develop their employability skills. Learning 4 Life aim to support every young person to progress positively into further education or employment. As part of the Learning 4 Life programme every young person can access the qualifications and awards. All learners are encouraged to complete at least one ESW qualification and a range of Agored awards that are best suited to their needs.
