What do we do?

We are a team of social workers, based at Llandough Hospital and we work within the Social Services, Adult Division of the Vale of Glamorgan Council.

As a result of being in hospital people sometimes need additional help to return to the community. The social workers, together with hospital colleagues are there to help with this and to ensure that the person's discharge is safe.

We can give advice for practical and emotional difficulties. Support and counselling for individuals and their carers is available at what is often a stressful and emotional time.

Who is the service for?

The Team works with patients whether they are resident in the Vale of Glamorgan or Cardiff. Those who live further a field will be referred on to Social Services Departments in their Home Counties.
