What do we do?

We provide specialist and holistic assessments for disabled people. After an assessment, assistance tailored to the needs of the individual will be arranged which aim to maximise independence, make safe care possible and aid social inclusion.

The Team includes Occupational Therapists and Occupational Therapy Assistants.

In addition to assessments at home, an out patient clinic is in operation.

Who is the service for?

The service is for people of all ages in the following client groups:

- * adults,
- * elderly,
- * children,
- * learning disabilities,
- * Elderly Mentally Infirm, and
- * Mental Health
