Physical and Sensory Impairment

What do we do?

We provide a range of services, support and advice to help people live as independently as possible in their own homes and communities. When we can, we help remove the barriers that stand in the way of them pursuing their chosen lifestyle. The kind of help we can offer will depend on individual needs. Some of the services we provide are:

- Social Workers who carry out assessment and care management within the Unified Assessment framework.
- Specialist Social Workers who assess people who are deaf, hard of hearing, visually impaired or deafblind.
- Rehabilitation Officer who assesses and provides services for people who are visually impaired
- Equipment and Adaptations
- Day Services

If we cannot help directly, we may be able to suggest other organisations that can.

Who is the service for?

People aged between 18 and 70 with a physical and/ or sensory impairment. The service also provides advice and support for carers.

Priority is given to those whose physical safety, physical health or mental health is at risk.
