We provide a therapy and home care support service that focuses on working with clients, in their own homes, to increase their functional independence and reduce dependence on care.

Who is the service for?

Persons resident in the Vale of Glamorgan who:

- Have experienced a recent episode of ill health or reduction in functional ability;
- Have the physical and mental capabilities to participate in the rehabilitation process;
- Are motivated with the potential to benefit from a limited period of rehabilitation.
