What do we do?

We are part of the Private Sector Housing Section which contributes to the health, well being and safety of communities in the Vale. We seek to ensure the provision of good quality, affordable and appropriate accommodation for individuals and families by providing advice, assistance and support in relation to the following:

Housing Assistance (Grants)

- Adaptations
- Repair
- Renovation

Disabled Facilities Grants

Disabled Facilities Grants may be available if you are disabled or someone living with you is disabled.

Assistance may be available towards the cost of providing adaptations and facilities to enable the disabled person to continue to live in the property.

An applicant must either be the owner of the dwelling or be a tenant (including licensees). (This will not necessarily be the disabled person for whom the works are required).

- Penarth Central Renewal Area
