What is the European Blue Parking Badge for Disabled People?

The Blue Badge Scheme is to help people who have severely restricted mobility. The badge holder may be a driver or passenger.

A car displaying a Blue Badge is permitted to park closer to shops and public buildings - for example in Disabled Parking Bays or on double yellow lines.

The Blue Badge also entitles the holder to any special local parking facilities when visiting a member state of the European Union.

Who can have a Blue Badge?

People who are automatically entitled are:

- Children and Adults who are in receipt of the high rate mobility component of the Disability Living Allowance.
- People registered as blind under the National Assistance Act 1948.
- People in receipt of the War Pensions Mobility Supplement.

In addition, the following people may be eligible:

- People who have a permanent disability or illness that makes walking very difficult, or people who have a severe disability in both upper limbs. They may be issued with a badge after an assessment by a Social Worker, Contact Officer or Occupational Therapist; or on evidence provided by their General Practitioner.

Where can I apply for a Blue Badge?

Blue Badges are usually issued for a period of three years and you can be reassessed after this period. You may be asked to visit the Resource Centre for an assessment.

When you receive your badge you will be given a Department of Transport information booklet about the badge and how to use it. It is important that you read this booklet carefully as it tells you about the ways in which the Badge cannot be used.

If your application is successful you will be asked to provide two passport sized photographs, and there is a £2 fee for the badge.

The **Wales Mobility and Driving Assessment Service** is a registered charity and offers a service to help people to be as independent as possible with outdoor mobility. They offer free information and advice on a range of issues, as well as both driver and passenger assessments in vehicles.

Mae'r Bathodyn Glas hefyd yn galluogi'r deilydd i ddefnyddio unrhyw gyfleusterau parcio lleol arbennig, wrth ymweld â gwlad sy'n aelod o'r Undeb Ewropeaidd.

Pwy all gael Bathodyn Glas?

Mae'r canlynol yn gymwys yn awtomatig i dderbyn y bathodyn:

- Plant ac Oedolion sy'n derbyn cyfradd uchel o'r elfen symudedd o'r Lwfans Byw i Bobl Anabl
- Pobl sydd wedi cofrestru'n ddall o dan Ddeddf Cymorth Gwladol 1948
- Pobl sy'n derbyn Lwfans Symudedd Pensiwn Rhyfel

Fe allai'r bobl a ganlyn hefyd fod yn gymwys:

- Pobl sydd ag anabledd neu salwch parhaol sy'n ei gwneud hi'n anodd iawn iddynt gerdded, neu bobl sydd ag anabledd difrifol yn nau aelod ucha'r corff. Os bydd eich cais yn llwyddiannus, bydd gofyn i chi ddarparu dau lun maint pasbort, ac fe godir ffi o £2 am y bathodyn.
