

The Barry Declaration

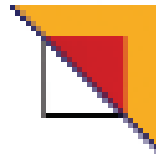
The Barry Declaration was agreed at a Twinning Meeting at the Vale of Glamorgan Civic Offices, Barry, on Saturday, 18th October 2003. The Declaration affirms the:

- *creation of a wider international partnership by building on the Twinning Agreements involving the Vale of Glamorgan (Wales), Rheinfelden (Germany), Mouscron (Belgium) and Fecamp (France) to incorporate Friendship Agreements with Putnok (Hungary), Jurbarkas (Lithuania), Neumarkt (Italy) and Rheinfelden (Switzerland);*
- *staging of an annual event, alternately focussing on cultural and economic issues, until otherwise agreed;*
- *cessation of the Easter Games.*

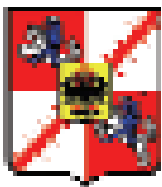

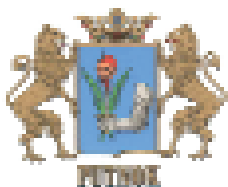

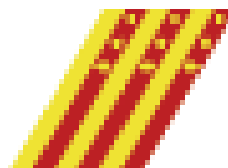
