- Aim of the YMCA Hub project is to launch a successful not-for-profit community centre with a variety of purposes, to encourage everyone of all ages and abilities to participate in local life and learn new skills;

- The centre will provide essential education, social, health, recreation and support services to the local community;
- The new premises will be integrated with the YMCA's existing building on derelict land in the Cadoxton area of Barry;

• Facilities will include:

- A large café offering good quality affordable food
- Childcare area
- After school activities for young people
- Day centre for adults with high dependency needs
- IT suites
- Range of training courses
- Seven office spaces for charities and community groups

• £2.2 million funding from:

 - Dow Corning
 - WAG's Community Facilities and Activities Programme
- The scheme represents a unique initiative in Wales of this operation and will create 11 new jobs.
