

## Week 4 Product Recalls

### Wk 4 15 0094/08 Spider-man Flying Saucer Type/number of model: Item No 2008.

Description: The flying saucer is black plastic with a spider web design. The packaging is a colourful cardboard box with a clear plastic centre. Toy Radio Controlled. Product consists of a flying saucer, remote control trigger gun, and a transformer/adaptor which is used to charge the product. Packaging is cardboard with images of Spider Man on it.

Country of origin: China

THE PRODUCT MIGHT BE COUNTERFEIT.

Electric shock

The product poses a risk of electric shock because:

- the pins of the plug part of the adaptor are accessible when it is partly inserted into a class 0 socket-outlet and the pins make contact with the contacts,
- the charger unit consist of a 2 pin transformer unit which is then connected to an adaptor plug. The safe operation of the charger unit cannot be assured as it is possible to connect the 2 pin transformer unit in any of 3 different positions on the adaptor (i.e. L to E, L to N, E TO N).

In addition the toy or the packaging was not marked with the name, trademark or identification mark of the manufacturer or responsible vendor.



### Wk 4 12 0091/08 Russ Snowy Days Scarves Type/number of model: Item No: 33234 item No: 33230 – Snowy Days Wearables (scarves only).

Description: Different knitted scarves of various colours with knitted animal heads.

Country of origin: China

Choking and strangulation

The product poses a risk of choking and strangulation because:

- conventional neckties, i.e. similar to those worn by adults, are not suitable for children under five years old. Neck ties for children in this age group should be designed to be easily detachable should they become entangled. This can be achieved by the use of touch and close fastenings at the neckband or the use of a clip-on fastening,
- the scarf was child appealing and was intended to be worn by young children. The presence of the animal head increased the likelihood that the scarf would be worn by children under five years of age.
