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## DUNRAVEN BAY

Dunraven Bay is much loved by the locals and attracts thousands of visitors every year, although officially called Dunraven Bay, it is also often referred to as Southerndown beach taking its name from the nearby village. This beach is a great place to fossil hunt and has some of the best rock pools along the coast, has a great sandy beach, large car-park and visitor facilities. 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## THREE GOLDEN CUPS WAK TAITH TRI CHWGAN AUR

DISTANCE: 4 km / 2.49 miles  
 PELLTER: 4 km / 2.49 milltir

A moderate walk through woodland, Southerndown village and back along the cliffs. Good views and a refreshment stop. Look out for Three Golden Cups symbol which is based on the crest of the Butler family, who used to live at Dunraven. Look out for the Dunraven crest at the main gateway to the park representing Caroline of Dunraven.

- As you leave the Heritage Coast Centre, turn right following the road. At the metal vehicle barrier, walk through the metal gate to the right. Follow the wooded track until you see a "Private Road" sign. Go through the gate to the right, bearing left.
- Go through a metal kissing gate on the left.
- Walk diagonally across the field and towards a set of steps with a stone stile. Continue up the steps and over the stone stile, following the left hand boundary of the field until you reach the road.
- Turn left. Cross over to the Three Golden cups pub and continue following the road.
- As the main road bends to the left, continue straight on, passing South Terrace on the right.
- At the crossroads take the Bridleway to the left. Continue, passing through a metal gate until you meet the road.
- Turn right going through the gate at the side of the cattle grid and cross over the road to the seaward side (opposite Little West Bungalows).
- Follow the waymarker towards the sea, keeping the wall to the left. Turn left by the concrete bollards following the Wales Coastal Path with the sea on the right and the wall to the left. Continue along the coast until you reach the metal kissing gates on the left leading to the car park.
- Walk across the car park to the Dunraven Park gateway taking the footpath to the left side of the road. Continue down the hill returning to Visitor Centre.

## THE THREE WAKS DUNRAVEN TAIR TAITH DWRNHEFN

DISTANCE: 2.4 km / 1.5 miles  
 PELLTER: 2.4 km / 1.5 milltir

A short circular walk going through the walled gardens around the headland of Dunraven Castle Site. The walk is marked turning round at (2.3 km) wael fario ac mae'n sgwern (2.3 km) wael fario ac mae'n troi o'r wrth Castell Dwrnhefn. Mae'r sgwern yn 2.4 awr o'r ychydig. Mae'n ddenu nifer fawr o ymwelwyr bob blwyddyn. Er mai Bae Dwrnhefn yw ei enw swyddogol, gwelir Southerndown amon o'r enw hwn yn aml, ar ôl y pentref cyfagos. Mae'n bae trwm gyda ffosiliau, ac mae'n gael ymlyniad i ffosiliau a phobol yn ymuno â'r bae i chwilio am ffosiliau.

- Start the walk at West Lodge, walking through the postern gate.
- Follow the road until you reach the walled gardens. Go through the postern gate.
- Follow the information panel turning left, through turning right.
- Pass the information panel turning left, through turning right.

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

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# THREE PUBS COAST AND COMMONS

## WAIK TAITH

### TAIR TAFARN ARFORDIR A CHOMIN

DISTANCE:  
7.3 km / 4.5 miles



Circular walk through wider countryside and coast. Good views and refreshment stops.

Taith gylchol drwy gefn gwlad eang ac ar hyd yr arfordir. Golygfeydd da a chyfluoedd i aros am luniaeth.

- 1 From the Heritage Coast Centre look out for the Pistyll, an historic watering hole in the wall on the right hand side. Go through the wooden gate turning left as the path splits.
- 2 At the kissing gate carry straight on following the field boundary.
- 3 Go through the kissing gate and across the stone stile on the right. Continue following the field boundary.
- 4 At the metal kissing gate, cross over to the left hand corner of the field and through a metal gate.
- 5 At the stone stile and gate go through, turn right and follow fence veering right.
- 6 At the wooden stile, go straight on.
- 7 Go through the kissing gate at the end of the wall.
- 8 Go over stone stile and continue until you reach the road.
- 9 At the Farmer's Arms turn left.
- 10 Pass St Brides Pond on the left.
- 11 Follow the road round to the right passing the stone sculpture, which is a gateway feature to mark the Glamorgan Heritage Coast.
- 12 Turn left after the shop. The Fox and Hounds pub is on the right.
- 13 Follow the sign to the 12th Century church continuing along the road uphill.
- 14 As the tarmac ends proceed on to the common taking the middle path straight on.
- 15 At the waymarker post turn left continuing with the fence line to the right.
- 16 As the footpath ends take the road signposted to "Southerndown". At Groes Farm follow the bridleway straight on.
- 17 At the road turn right and cross over opposite Little West bungalows following the waymarker to the sea. Turn left.
- 18 Continue with the wall on the left hand side and sea on the right. Walk through the metal kissing gate on the left and across the car park to the Dunraven Park entrance. Follow the footpath downhill on the inland side of the road.

- 1 O Ganolfan yr Arfordir Trefadaeth cadwch lygad am y Pistyll, dyfrle hanesyddol yn y wal ar y llaw dde. Ewch drwy'r gât bren a thro'i i'r chwith pan fydd y llywbr yn rhannu.
- 2 Wrth y gât mochyn parhewch yn syth ymlaen gan ddilyn ffin deryn y cae.
- 3 Ewch drwy'r gât mochyn a dros y gamfa garreg ar y dde. Parhewch i ddilyn ffin deryn y cae.
- 4 Wrth y gât mochyn fetel, croeswch draw i gomel dde y cae a thro'i y gât fetel.
- 5 Wrth y gamfa garreg ewch trwy'r gât trowch i'r dde a dilyn y fflens gan wyro i'r dde.
- 6 Wrth y gamfa bren ewch yn syth ymlaen.
- 7 Ewch drwy'r gât mochyn ar ddiwedd y wal.
- 8 Ewch dros y gamfa garreg a pharhewch nes i chi grraedd y ffordd.
- 9 Wrth dafarn y Farmer's Arms trowch i'r chwith.
- 10 Ewch heibio i Bwll Saint-y-brid ar y chwith.
- 11 Dilynwch y ffordd o amgylch i'r dde gan fynd heibio cerllun carreg, sy'n borth i nodi Arfordir Trefadaeth Morgannwg.
- 12 Trowch i'r chwith wedi'r siop. Mae tafarn y Fox and Hounds ar y dde.
- 13 Dilynwch yr arwydd i'r eglwys o'r ddeuddegfed ganif gan barhau ar y ffordd i fyny'r rhw.
- 14 Wrth i'r tarmac ddod i ben ewch ymlaen ar y tir comin gan ddilyn y llywbr canol yn syth ymlaen.
- 15 Wrth y postyn marcwr llywbr trowch i'r chwith gan barhau gyda linell y ffens ar y dde.
- 16 Pan ddaw'r llywbr troed i ben dilynwch y ffordd sydd ag arwydd "Southerndown". Yn Fferm y Groes dilynwch y llywbr cefylau yn syth ymlaen.
- 17 Pan ddewch i'r ffordd trowch i'r dde a throesi gyferbyn â bynglos Little West gan ddilyn y marcwr llywbr i gfeiniad y môr. Trowch i'r chwith.
- 18 Parhewch gyda'r wal ar y llaw chwith a'r môr ar y dde. Cerddwch drwy'r gât mochyn fetel ar y chwith ac ar draws y maes parcio i fynedfa Parc Dunraven. Dilynwch y llywbr troed i lawr y rhw ar ochr fewndrol y ffordd.
