


Reggie is going on an adventure into space, he needs someone to go with him and help fly the space rocket.







Can you help him get all his equipment ready for take off




Reggie is going to travel to the moon on a space rocket.

- ☐ In a curved line






The rocket blasts off into Space, whizzing towards the moon and stars

- ☐ Shapes whilst leaning out the front of your chair




Whilst flying to the moon, Reggie has to get his space suit on ready for landing.

The space suit is at the other end of the rocket, so Reggie has to move along the ship to get to it.

- Controlled movements whilst out of your chair






The rocket has landed on the moon, and Reggie is ready to go explore.

- ☐ Objects on the floor




Reggie moves through the door and onto the surface of the moon.

- □ Open a door and go through it






Reggie can see an alien's tail poking out under a huge pile of space rocks.


Reggie has to get over there as quickly as possible to help them.

- ☐ Moving Backwards in a curved direction












Reggie makes friends with the alien and teaches them to play some games from Earth.

- Stopping an object using your chair






Reggie and his Alien friend finish playing as Reggie has to return to Earth. Reggie climbs on board his space rocket and flies back to Earth just in time for his Tea.

What actions were the most fun to do? Can you think why they were fun?


