REMEMBER TO STAY 2 METRES APART FROM

- Make a pair of binoculars to spot the animals on the ground, ahead or up high. (TIP: Use your recycling).
- Pack a drawing pad and pencils to write down or draw the different animals or bugs you see.

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DURING YOUR TRIP OR BACK AT HOME...

- Can you...
Run as fast as a cheetah? (The world's fastest animal)
Jump around like a kangaroo?

Walk like a bear?
Shuffle like a spider?
- How many swans, seagulls or birds can you count?
(Find a grass patch and try to fly like a bird or draw one of them).
- How many different types of bugs can you find?
(Use a magnifying glass to look at the bark or search through the grass or soil).
- Make a den to watch out for passing animals.
