

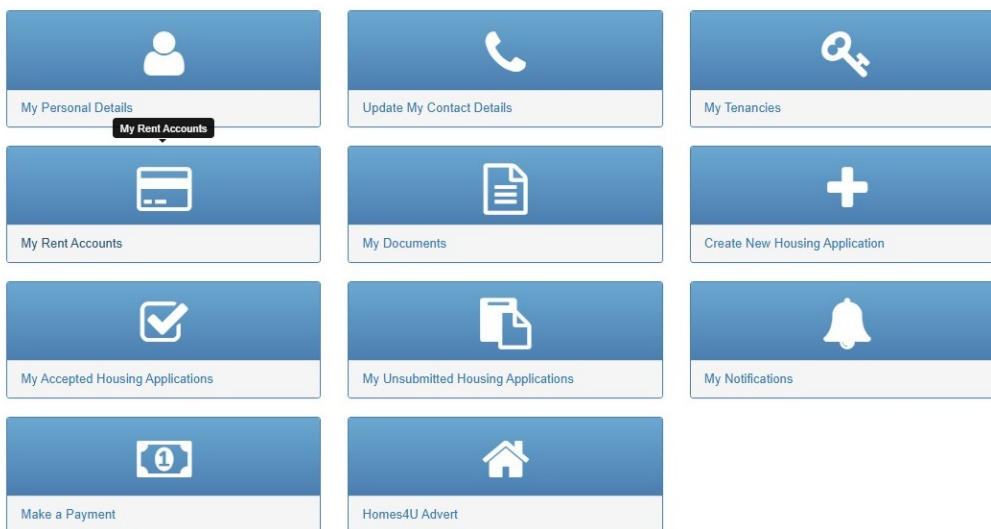
How to View Your Rent Statement

If you are a **fortnight or monthly payer**, your payments will need to be in advance. i.e. if you're a monthly payer, your account should be a month in credit when payment is made for that month. Failure will result in your account being in arrears and arrears action will continue.
