

Proportion of all accidental fires caused by smokers materials





Figure 8: Proportion of fires caused by smokers' materials compared with proportion of casualties Source: FDR1, Fire Incident Data collection forms




Number of accidental fires in dwellings in Wales: 1998 - 2008

Older people are 'over represented'





Over Representation and Risk Factors

Fire incidence going down but not for everyone...some groups of people are still over-represented

Also evidence to suggest there are certain socio-demographic factors which contribute to heightened risk of fire:

- •Being single including single adults and single parents
- Deprivation
- Mental/physical impairment
- Careless use of smokers materials
- Alcohol



A study of 535 fatal Fire Investigation Report in the UK (2006) concluded that, "alongside the immediate causes of a fire (e.g. carelessly discarded cigarettes) alcohol, mobility and mental illness are the biggest single influences on whether a fire starts and/or whether it has fatal consequences".




Prevention of consequences!
