I am totally opposed to the proposed development at model farm for several reasons- the roads could not possibly cope with the extra traffic, the slightest hitch on the roads now almost brings Rhosce to a stop !

The environmental cost would be monumental- however much Legal and General say they will mitigate the loss. How can we have declared a Climate Emergency and a Nature Emergency - it makes no sense to create a concrete jungle with some green landscaping on prosperous green fields.
