

Application for a Footpath Order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

- Application Form AP 01 attached along with 11 Evidence User Forms, Map showing the route (double pecked lines) on a scale of 1:2500 and extract from a street map circa 2005 (single pecked line)
- Copy of Form AP 02 attached – served at Civic Offices

- I would point out that you were consulted on Application 2012/00614/RG3 and in your response dated 28th June 2012 you acknowledged the existence of the claimed route as an unrecorded public right of way. The Planning Report refers to the claimed route as a 'Public Footpath' that will need to be diverted. In order to divert the public footpath it will first need to be recorded on the Definitive Map and Statement in accordance with s.53 of the Wildlife and Countryside Act and the proposed diversion be conducted by way of a Legal Event Modification Order.
- Please note that the street map extract also shows another route in the locality of the Open Space leading from Collard Crescent/Caradoc Avenue to Laburnum Close so it would be beneficial that in the course of conducting your investigation into the claimed route that this route also be considered as a potential unrecorded public right of way
