Aberthaw Power Station – Footpaths Deposit of Statement and Plan Section 31 (6) of the Highways Act 1980

- Innogy plc and its predecessors in title has since 1960 been the owner (as defined in the Highways Act 1980) of the land known as Aberthaw Power Station more particularly delineated edged red on the plan accompanying this statement.
- 2. The aforementioned land lies in the Parish of Rhoose.
- The footpaths coloured purple and numbered 14 and 19 on the plan are existing Public Rights of Way
- 4. The routes shown on the plan numbered from 1 to 12 have been dedicated as Permissive Footpaths and are not Public Rights of Way. The individual details are as follows. The length in metres of each path is quoted in brackets.
 - 1. Follows the track from the rail bridges to path no 8. (254m)
 - 2. A short winding path linking the low-lying paths 8 and 3, with the Public Right of Way no 19.

 - 6. Follows the boundary fence along the east side of the tip and extends to the sea wall. (363m)
 - 7. Links the Public Right of Way no 19 to permissive path no 8 (202m)
 - Starts at Public Right of Way no 14 where steps have been provided to bring the path inside
 the sea wall. The path then runs inside the sea wall, around the Lagoon and ends where it joins
 paths 10 and 11. (127m)
 - 9. A short length of path linking path 8 to path 12. (20m)
 - 10. A short length of path linking path 8 to path 12. (30m)
 - 11. A continuation of path 8 including a short section linking to path 12. (352m)
 - 12. Follows the disused railway from path 11 to the end of Well Road. (572in)
 - 14. (1777m)
 - 19. (1818m)
- 5. No other routes over the land have been dedicated as highways.
