

# Nursery Education

## What is it?

Nursery education in a school nursery class: 12.5 hours per week in term time, usually 5 morning or afternoon sessions per week. Your school can give you more information.

## Who is it for?

3 - 4 year olds  
in the Vale of Glamorgan.

## When do I apply?

Applications open up to 15 months before your child starts nursery education. Sign up for a reminder to apply on our Nursery Admissions website.

## When does it start?

From the school term after your child's 3rd birthday -  
Your school will tell you the exact date.

## When does it stop?

The end of the summer term before your child starts full-time school. You will need to reapply for a full-time school place.

# The Childcare Offer

## What is it?

Funded childcare:  
up to 17.5 hours per week in term time.  
30 hours per week in the school holidays for 9 weeks a year.

## Who is it for?

Eligible students and working parents of 3 - 4 year olds.  
Visit our Childcare Offer website for more information.

## When do I apply?

Applications open 10 weeks before the funding starts. Sign up for a reminder to apply on the Vale of Glamorgan's Childcare Offer website.

## When does it start?

From the start of the school term after your child's 3rd birthday.  
Check our website for exact dates.

## When does it stop?

If you remain eligible for the Childcare Offer, the funding can continue until the August before your child starts full-time school.
