**Thank you for your interest in this survey.**

Active Travel is the name given for everyday, short distance journeys that people can make either on foot or by cycle such as to work, school or to reach the shops and other facilities. This can also include users of wheelchairs or other mobility aids. It does not refer to journeys that people may make for recreational reasons, such as walking or cycling in the countryside.

The Council would like to improve the quality and provision of walking, wheeling and cycling routes throughout the Vale of Glamorgan, and this survey will help us to do that.

**The survey runs from 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2026 until 14<sup>th</sup> September 2026.**

To take part, please can you first have a look at the Active Travel Network Map (ATNM) which shows the existing and planned network of active travel routes that the Council would like to see developed in the Vale of Glamorgan in order to promote more walking, wheeling and cycling.

Many of the planned new routes will require further study into the possible design of these new routes including the estimated cost and engineering and environmental impact.

Following feedback from previous consultation exercises, we have tried to ensure that all these routes connect to form a network and enable residents to reach nearby facilities from their communities, both safely and conveniently.

We have put together several questions about the network of routes shown on the ATNM and would welcome your comments by completing the survey.

All responses received by the Vale of Glamorgan will be viewed in full by officers involved in this exercise. Although we cannot respond individually, we will add all raised issues to our consultation report. This will be available online or by request in future, after we close the consultation and review feedback.
