The zones are **East Vale**, **West Vale** and **External Vale**.

- Please note '**External Vale**' is limited to Porthcawl, Bridgend, Llantrisant (inc. Royal Glamorgan Hospital) and Cardiff. Please see diagram overleaf.
- Concessionary Bus Passes are not valid for use on the Greenlinks service except when Greenlinks operates as a local bus service (as advertised).
- Please telephone to request a journey as far in advance as possible. Requests must be made by 12 noon on the day prior to travel at the very latest. Requests on the day of travel will not be accepted. The phone line will be open from 9.00am to 1.00pm each day Monday to Friday.

- On weekends and evenings the vehicle will be available for hire to charitable or non profit making groups at very competitive rates.

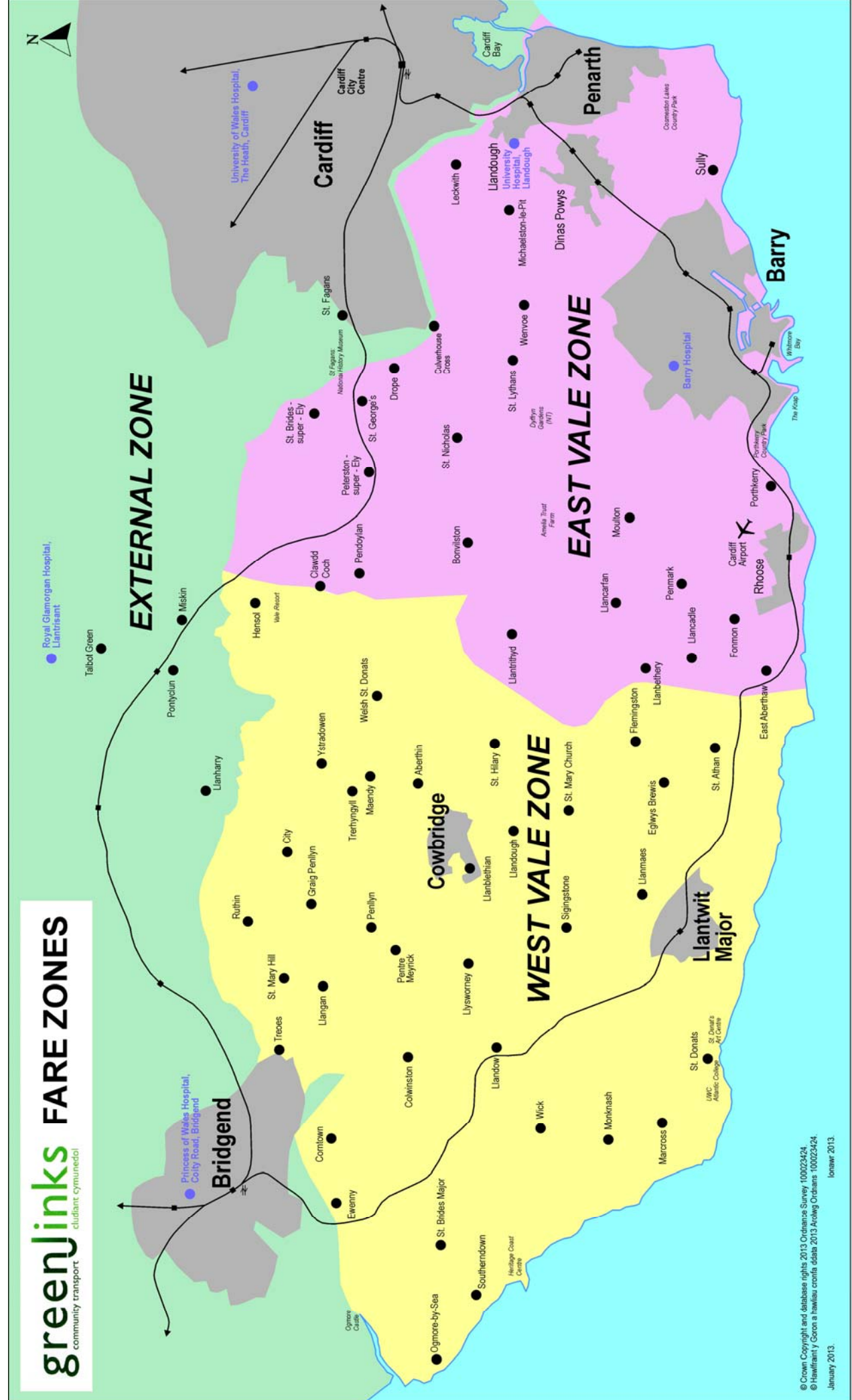
