

**THE VALE OF GLAMORGAN COUNCIL
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND
LOADING AND PARKING PLACES)**

(CIVIL ENFORCEMENT) (AMENDMENT) (NO 4) ORDER 2020

1. On the 17th June 2020 The Vale of Glamorgan Council in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and all other enabling powers made an Order to install the parking restrictions specified in the schedule below.
2. The Order will come into operation on 22nd June 2020 or on the dates that the signs and road markings are installed whichever is the later and be known as the “Vale of Glamorgan Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement) (Amendment) (No 4) Order 2020”
3. A copy of the Order and plans showing the affected areas may be seen at www.valeofglamorgan.gov.uk
4. If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provisions contained therein on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the above Act or on the grounds that any requirement of the same or that any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks from the 22nd June 2020 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The following Traffic Regulation Order is to be amended as follows:

Proposed Prohibition of Waiting at Any Time.

St Pauls Avenue, Barry.

On the north western side from the boundary of properties Nos 60 and 62 in a south-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 4 metres.

On the north western side from a point approximately 11 metres south west of the boundary of property Nos 60 and 62 in a south westerly for a distance of approximately 19 metres.
