

**THE VALE OF GLAMORGAN COUNCIL
(DRYDEN ROAD, PENARTH) (SCHOOL STREET)
(PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES)
TRAFFIC ORDER 2026**

1. On the 24th June 2026 the Vale of Glamorgan Council in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers made an Order the general effect of which is as described in the Schedules below.
2. The Order will come into operation on the 29th June 2026 or on the date that the signs and road markings are in place, whichever is the later and shall be referred to as The Vale of Glamorgan Council (Dryden Road, Penarth) (School Street) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Traffic Order 2026.
3. A copy of the Order and plans showing the affected areas may be seen on the Council's website at www.valeofglamorgan.gov.uk
4. If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provisions contained therein on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the above Act or on the grounds that any requirement of the same or that any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may within six weeks from the 29th June 2026 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

SCHEDULE 1

No person shall cause or permit any Motor Vehicle to enter and proceed along the length of road described in Schedule 2 below, during term time, between the hours of 08:00 and 09:15 and between the hours of 15:00 and 16:00 on any day other than a Saturday or Sunday, unless exempt, as set out in the articles to this Order.

SCHEDULE 2

**Prohibition of Motor Vehicles – Monday to Friday 08.00 to 09.15 and 15.00 to 16.00
During School Term Time only**

Dryden Road (Part), Penarth

From a point approximately 15.5 metres from its junction with Tennyson Road, in a generally easterly and southerly direction, to its junction with Wordsworth Avenue. A distance of approximately 235 metres.
