- develop and enhance their understanding of the role of an effective Chair in leading the governing body;
- enhance their confidence and leadership skills and their ability to develop effective relationships with their headteacher, enabling them to offer both challenge and support to the school;
- be aware of national and local educational issues and their impact on governing bodies; and
- recognise the importance of training and the need to develop their skills and those
 of the governing body and take advantage of other training opportunities available
 to them.

Additional Learning Needs and Education Tribunal Act



Presented by Liz Jones, ALN Transformation Lead, Central South Consortium

In January 2018 the Additional Learning Needs and Education Tribunal Act received royal assent alongside a mandatory timeline for implementation. Implementation of the new system will commence in September 2020 with completion expected by the end of 2023.



The Welsh Government is supporting the transformation of the new system through five key themes:

- Legislation and statutory guidance
- Workforce development
- Implementation and transition support
- Awareness raising
- Supporting policy

This session will provide an opportunity for governors to develop their understanding of the implications of the ALNET Act for schools and local authorities and what progress has been made within the region against the five key themes.
