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Skills Offered

For young people aged 16 – 19 who are experiencing difficulties in mainstream education, in particular: •pupils who have been permanently excluded •pupils excluded more than twice from mainstream schools •those subject to Education Supervision Orders •pupils returning from secure accommodation •young people who have not engaged in formal education for more than 12 months guidance and nationally recognised qualifications for young people aged 16+ who are not yet ready to access work or study. We offer a Traineeships programme that supports young people aged 16 - 18 who have left formal education at 16 but have not gone into further education, training or employment. Level 1 – this part of the programme focuses on employment skills and gaining real work experience. At this stage, the young person will spend 30 hours a week at the centre and on work placement. We offer apprenticeships with Rathbone in the following areas: •Business Administration •Children and Young People's Workforce •Customer Service •Health and Social Care •Hospitality and Catering •Information and Communication Technology (ICT) •Retail Motor Industry •Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools •Warehouse and Storage •Youth Work •Team Leading •Managing Volunteers •Fundraising

Engagement programme is 21 hours a week, for up to 20 weeks, pays £30 to a young person per week. Young person will gain essential skills entry level, level 1 in soft skills, work placement.
