Participating organisations will develop clean growth plans that could be eligible for Welsh Government innovation funding.

We're bringing businesses together from across the Vale of Glamorgan to collaboratively develop their circular economy understanding and innovation plans to support clean growth and contribute to Welsh Government's 'Net Zero Wales' ambitions.

You'll join people from a variety of organisations and participate in a programme of interactive, output focused workshops. You will learn innovation methods and tools that enhance can productivity, increase customers satisfaction and deliver Circular Economy benefits. You'll be supported to develop innovation plans that can be implemented and signposted to innovation funding. The programme is designed for people who can influence service and product development.

The 6-month programme will include

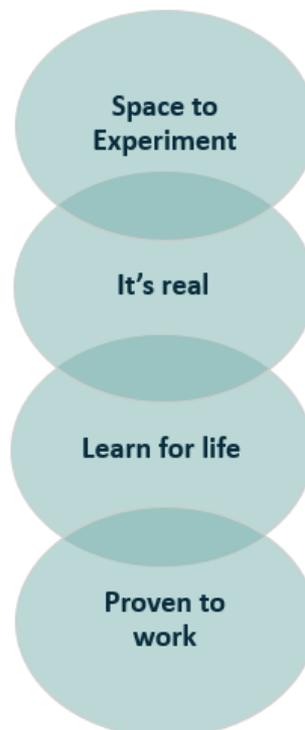
- Monthly workshops to develop innovation skills and build strong networks to support innovation plan development.
