Mae Llywodraeth Cymru a Banc Datblygu Cymru wedi cyhoeddi Cynllun Benthyciad Busnes £100m Cymru i gefnogi busnesau a effeithiwyd arnynt gan yr achosion o Cofid-19.

Bydd y Cynllun ar gael gan Banc Datblygu Cymru am gyfnod cyfyngedig. Y bwriad yw darparu cefnogaeth i fusnesau sy'n profi anawsterau llif arian o ganlyniad i'r pandemig.

Bydd y cynllun benthyciadau yn gweithio ochr yn ochr â'r [Cynllun Ymyrryd ar Fusnes Coronafirws](#) ar draws y DU, cynigion cymorth eraill Llywodraeth Cymru a Llywodraeth y DU, gan ddarparu opsiynau mwy hanfodol i fusnesau Cymru.

Mae benthyciadau rhwng £5,000 a £250,000 ar gael i fusnesau sydd wedi bod yn masnachu am fwy na 2 flynedd lle gallant ddangos eu bod wedi gallu gwasanaethu'r lefel honno o ddyled cyn y coronafirws.

The Welsh Government and the Development Bank of Wales have announced the £100m Covid-19 Wales Business Loan Scheme to support businesses affected by the Covid-19 outbreak.

The Scheme will be available from the Development Bank of Wales for a limited period. It is intended to provide support to businesses who are experiencing cash flow difficulties as a result of the pandemic.

The loan scheme will work alongside the UK wide [Coronavirus Business Interruption Loan Scheme](#), other Welsh Government and UK Government support offers, providing more vital options for Welsh businesses.

Loans of between £5,000 and £250,000 are available to businesses who have been trading longer than 2 years and can demonstrate that they were able to service that level of debt before the outbreak.
