Dear Mike; We have only now been able to meet and discuss a response to be considered by cabinet.

We are concerned at the continuing dilapidated state of the site as a whole, as are the residents of Cowbridge. The initial agreement to allow the VMAG a year to come up with firm financial proposals has clearly expired, although we note that the key funding route for them is a proposed Lottery grant of £650,000, for which they anticipate an initial decision during the course of this month. For this reason we feel that consideration of today's report should be deferred until the outcome of the Lottery application is known.

In the event that cabinet disregards our suggestion, then we would make the following observations;

We are aware that at least one approach has been made to the council by a commercial organization which would incorporate the requirements of the VMAG. Have these alternative proposals been considered by cabinet?

There is an urgent demand for older persons' residential housing in Cowbridge, and we feel any housing should be so designated.

We are most unhappy at the proposal to delegate any further extensions of time with no longstop date envisaged.

We have of course other concerns, but in view of the short time made available to us for comment, these can be provided at a later date.
