As the Local Ward Member I would like to bring to your attention a proposal that relates to a report that will be presented to Cabinet on the above date.

Report provides Cabinet with an update on the new junction and road works currently being undertaken at Cardiff Road, Dinas Powys. These works are due to be completed in March 2017 with the work to remove the substandard bridge deck due to be let shortly. It is proposed that this deck be removed as soon as possible on completion of the new junction. Should there be any delay, the bridge will be closed to vehicular access and the timber supporting props will be removed in the intervening period.

As the Member who originally brought this matter to the attention of Rob Quick and Senior Officers in 2001 I am delighted to hear that the bridge will soon be gone. Local residents are convinced that the bridge was the main cause of flooding to their properties over the last 2 decades and will be equally pleased to see it gone. The new junction will be a big help to traffic and I should be most grateful to know when the bridge will actually be dismantled.

I have personally led the campaign to create the junction and remove the bridge throughout my 16 years as a Vale Councillor and have liaised and arranged meetings directly with Senior officers, Cabinet Members, Welsh Water, the Environment Agency/NRW, and local residents so the end result will be most satisfactory to me and certain residents of St Cadocs Avenue, even though, regrettably, others seek to take the credit.
