**Alarm & Mobile Warden Service  
Eligibility Criteria for Supporting People funding****Alarms****Over 60 years old**

At risk of a slip, trip or fall

**Under 60 years old**

People who are disabled or have a disabling illness (as evidenced by receipt of Personal Independence Payments, Disability Living Allowance, or Attendance Allowance; or medical evidence for those not yet in receipt of benefits claimed)

and at risk of a slip, trip or a fall.

**At Risk of Domestic Abuse**

Following the completion of a CAADA / DASH checklist IDVA and client have identified an alarm will reduce a risk or the perceived risk to the individual.

**Mobile Warden Service (Cardiff Only)**

In receipt of Housing Benefit or Council Tax Reduction

And one of the following:

- Over 80 years old and at risk of slips, trips and falls  
or
- Significant Mobility issues (as evidenced by receipt of relevant disability benefit \*)  
or
- An illness that may result in slips trips and falls (confirmed by medical practitioner or Occupational Therapist)

\* Mobility PIP or Mobility DLA

**New clients**

- The criteria will apply to all new clients from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2018

**Existing Clients**

- There will be no change to the service for existing clients
