# C101 USE OF THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE'S EMERGENCY POWERS (EL/PR) (SCRUTINY – ALL) –

The Leader presented the report, the purpose of which was to notify Cabinet of the exercising of Emergency Powers by the Chief Executive since the last report on 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2023, for matters such as moving on contracts or accepting and using

grant funding. The Leader referred to previous funding allocated to country parks under the Brilliant Basics Fund that was now being used at St Donats.

Councillor John referred to 'Belle Vue Community Centre' in Penarth where the use of Emergency Powers had allowed for the official opening of the centre on 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2023. The response from the public had been positive and Councillor John looked forward to working with the Big Fresh Catering to develop the centre.

Councillor Birch referred to the 'Ysgol y Deri Expansion Project' and was pleased with the progress made, as well as 'Summer Holiday Free Schools Meals Support' which was an important offering to families that required support over that period.

Councillor Wilson referred to the 'Increase Capital Budget for the Eastern Shelter Refurbishment Scheme' as the Vale Council had been proactive in identifying issues in the Vale area and was pleased the project had been delivered and showed continuing investment in the Island.
