Report Title:	Capital Monitoring for the Period 1st April to 30th June 2025
Purpose of Report:	To advise Cabinet of the progress on the 2025/26 Capital Programme for the period 1st April 2025 to 30th June 2025 and to request changes to the Capital Programme.
Report Owner:	Executive Leader and Cabinet Member for Performance and Resources
Responsible Officer:	Head of Finance/S151 Officer

Executive Summary:

- The report provides an update on the progress of the Capital Programme for the period 1st April 2025 to 30th June 2025. Details by scheme are shown in Appendix 1.
- Appendix 2 provides a summary of the position of the Capital Programme by directorate from approval at Full Council on 6th March 2024 through to 30th June 2025, including any changes requested within this report.
- The report sets out any requested changes to the 2025/26 and future years' Capital Programme.
- The report notes the current approved programme of £129.441m and details the movements to the revised programme of £126.955m.
- It is important to note that many areas are continuing to experience an increase in costs associated with delivery of schemes. Tenders are being received over the current allocated budgets and officers are reporting the requirement to re-negotiate submitted tenders.
- Officers will continue to work with project managers and sponsors to ensure value for money and that all possible funding opportunities are identified and are fully explored.

Recommendations

 - ENABLE Include this Welsh Government grant of £343k into the 2025/26 Capital Programme.
 - Neighbourhood Services Highways Improvements Increase this scheme budget in the 2025/26 and 2026/27 Capital Programme and vire budget to a new scheme for LGBI Footways and LGBI Structures as indicated in paragraph 2.12 to 2.14 of this report.
 - Eastern Shelter and Barry Island Promenade Refresh and ANPR Rename this scheme in the 2025/26 Capital Programme, Barry Island ANPR and pay systems.
 - Car Park Refurbishment and new parking charges Merge the schemes for Residential Parking schemes and permits, Car Park Refurbishment and Ogmore by Sea Car Park Refurbishment in the 2025/26 Capital Programme.
 - Active Travel Allocate the Active Travel budget of £976k in the 2025/26 Capital Programme.
 - Active Travel Vire £6k Section 106 money to the ATNM improvement and development scheme in the 2025/26 Capital Programme.
 - SPF BSC/Engine Room Transformation Project Increase the budget for this scheme in the 2025/26 Capital Programme by £141k, to be funded from the Place reserve.
 - Extension to Cowbridge Primary Phase 2 (Iolo) Reprofile this scheme in the current and future years' Capital Programme as set out in paragraph 2.21
- **5.** That the 2025/26 Capital Programme is amended to reflect the revised leases arrangements that have/are due to commence in 2025/26 that meet the threshold for inclusion under IFRS16.

Reasons for Recommendations

- 2. To advise Cabinet of the use of Delegated Authority.
- 3. To advise Cabinet of the use of Emergency Powers.

1. Background

1.1 Council on 10th March 2025 approved the Capital Programme for 2025/26.

2. Key Issues for Consideration

2.1 The approved programme as at final proposals was £106.706m. Slippage from the 2024/25 Capital Programme of £14.329m has been previously agreed and added to the approved programme. During the financial year amendments totalling £8.406m have been approved, which gives a total current approved programme of £129.441m. A directorate analysis taken from Appendix 2 is set out in the Table One below:

- 2.3 Appendix 1 further notes schemes over £250k and a risk rating comment is provided. The schemes are coloured Green, Amber and Red to indicate the level of risk where green is the lowest and red the highest. The categorisation of schemes is set out below:
 - Green Low risk spend on track and expected to outturn on time to budget.
 - Amber Medium risk spend lower than profiled or some delay associated with scheme.
 - Red High risk little or no spend or scheme subject to requirement for additional funding or other delay.

Capital Programme Delivery

2.4 The paragraphs below provide details highlighting several capital schemes being delivered this financial year.

Environment - Transport

- 2.5 It is pleasing to note that external funds of £3.346m have been secured from Welsh Government in relation to Transport grants for 2025/26.
- 2.6 £976k of the above is from the Active Travel Fund to increase levels of active travel, improve health and well-being, improve air quality, reduce carbon emissions, connect communities and improve active travel access to employment, education and key services, destinations and public transport. One scheme delivered in this financial year has been the improved crossing point on Windsor Road, Penarth that provides a safer crossing point.

Place - Murchfield Community Space

- 2.8 Section 106 grant funding together with Shared Prosperity Funding and Sports Wales grant funding has been used to revitalise the former Murchfield courts area in Dinas Powys. A community consultation was undertaken in Summer 2023 and the main works commenced on site in January 2025.
- 2.9 The scheme includes a new multifunctional recreation and community space with integrated functional public art elements. The artist designed bench seating and surface artwork on the new basketball/netball court will be implemented in September 2025. The Council has opened the site in the meantime to allow people to use the space flexibly over the summer school holidays.

Capital Programme Additions, Virements and Re-Profiling

Learning & Skills

2.11 Holton Primary – Roof Renewal and Associated Works - This scheme was included in the 2024/25 Capital Programme. Although the main works were completed in 2024/25, additional works are required to the roof structure. Additional health and safety measures also needed to be adopted during the contract which meant further budget was required. A budget of £209k is currently on the 2025/26 Capital Programme for Victorian Schools General Maintenance and is unallocated. It is requested to vire £52k of this budget to the scheme for Holton Primary.

Social Services

2.12 ENABLE – The Council has received an award of funding of £343k from Welsh Government in relation to the ENABLE Grant for 2025/26. The purpose of this grant is to help older, disabled and vulnerable people by the delivery of adaptations to improve individual's ability to maintain independence at home. It is requested to include this new scheme in the 2025/26 Capital Programme with a budget of £343k, to be funded by Welsh Government grant.

Environment

- 2.13 Highways Resurfacing Local Government Borrowing Initiative The Final Capital Proposals report that went to Cabinet on 6th March 2025 highlighted that Welsh Government had confirmed it is making revenue support available to Councils to enable authorities to consider borrowing to undertake highways works under a Local Government Borrowing Initiative (LGBI). On this basis, a figure of £2.699m was included within the 2025/26 Capital Programme and £1.799m for 2026/27. Confirmation has now been received that funding will be £2.715m for 2025/26 and £1.810m for 2026/27. It has further been confirmed that this will be split between resurfacing, footways and structures.
- 2.14 It is requested to increase the highways resurfacing scheme in the 2025/26 and 2026/27 capital programme in line with the confirmation of budgets received from Welsh Government and vire £200k and £575k in the 2025/26 Capital Programme and £200k in the 2026/27 Capital Programme as indicated in the table:

- 2.16 Eastern Shelter and Barry Island Promenade Refresh and ANPR This scheme is currently in the 2025/26 Capital Programme with a budget of £310k. Works on the Eastern Shelter and Barry Island Promenade Refresh were completed in 2024/25. The only works outstanding are in relation to the final element of this scheme around the ANPR. It is requested to rename this scheme 'Barry Island ANPR and pay systems' in line with the works outstanding.
- 2.17 Car Park Refurbishment and new parking charges There are three schemes on the 2025/26 Capital Programme that relate to car parking. These are Residential Parking scheme and permits with a budget of £21k, Car Park refurbishment with a budget of £33k and Ogmore by Sea Car Park Refurbishment. It is requested to merge these three schemes to one scheme named Car Park Refurbishment and new parking infrastructure with a total budget of £139k
- 2.18 Active Travel Emergency Powers was approved to add the Active Travel grant to the 2025/26 Capital Programme with a budget of £976k. A variation was submitted and agreed by Welsh Government to allocate this budget to several schemes. It is requested to amend the 2025/26 Capital Programme in line with the table below:

2.19 Budget of £6k was approved to be carried forward to the Active Travel scheme, funded by Section 106. It is requested that this £6k be added to the ATNM improvement and development scheme for £250k. The total budget for this scheme will be £256k.

Place

- 2.20 SPF BSC/Engine Room Transformation project This scheme is currently in the 2025/26 Capital Programme with a budget of £200k, which is grant funding under the UK Government Shared Prosperity fund. On approval by the Shared Prosperity fund panel, the £200k was granted on the basis that £141k was allocated from the Place reserve. The scheme is to provide further decarbonisation measures at the Engine Room and the Business Service Centre (BSC) and the £141k will be utilised for an air source heat pump for the BSC.
- 2.21 It is requested to add the £141k to the 2025/26 Capital Programme, to increase the budget for this scheme. If the air source heat pump is not viable, this reserve will not be required.

Slippage

Learning & Skills (Pipeline)

2.22 Extension to Cowbridge Primary Phase 2 (Iolo) – Due to the change of the design to meet the new Welsh Government sustainable drainage requirements for the site, there is a ten-week delay to the scheme and spend on the project requires slipping. It is requested to reprofile the scheme budget to reflect the revised programme of works as per the table below:

Learning and Skills

2.24 Ysgol Dewi Sant Canopies - Delegated authority has been approved to include this new scheme in the 2025/26 Capital Programme to be funded from £175k of S106 money. The Council has received an education contribution which has enabled these works for the creation of two new external canopies at Ysgol Dewi Sant to provide additional outdoor learning space. One canopy will be off the main building and the other canopy will be the opposite side of the play yard.

Environment and Housing

2.25 Asset Renewal Scheme – Neighbourhood Service and Transport – Delegated authority has been approved to amend the asset renewal allocations in the 2025/26 Capital Programme as indicated in the table below:

- 2.26 Please note that since the approval of the Delegated Authority, a cabinet report has been approved to vire £58k from the Coastal Management budget to a new grant funded scheme for Barry Island Changing Facility and upgrade. The new budget for Coastal Management is £63k.
- 2.27 New Uncontrolled Crossing at entrance to Borough Close, Cowbridge—This scheme is included in the 2025/26 Capital Programme with a budget of £15k. Delegated authority has been approved to increase this scheme budget by £5k funded from \$106 money to undertake pedestrian improvement works at the entrance to Borough Close in Cowbridge.
- 2.28 Hayes Road, Barry Pedestrian Improvements -Delegated Authority has been approved to add this new scheme into the 2025/26 Capital Programme to undertake pedestrian improvements on Hayes Road, Barry. This budget of £48k will be funded by \$106 monies.
- 2.29 Buttrils Road, Barry Pedestrian Improvements Two delegated authorities have been approved to include this S106 scheme and increase the Council's Capital Programme for 2025/26. The first requested to include a budget of £40k to undertake pedestrian improvements on Buttrils Road, Barry and the second to include a budget of £27k to undertake further pedestrian improvements. The total for this scheme will be £67k.
- 2.30 Ham Lane East, Llantwit Major Controlled Crossing Delegated authority has been approved to include this new scheme in the 2025/26 Capital Programme with a budget of £185k to be funded from Section 106 money. The scheme will install a new controlled crossing on Ham Lane East, Llantwit Major.
- 2.31 S106 Public Open Space The Bendricks, Barry Delegated authority has been approved to increase the Council's Capital Programme 2025/26 by £139k to be funded from Section 106 money, to enhance the existing public open space adjacent to the café/roundabout at the Bendricks, Barry.

- 2.32 S106 Cross Inn Lane, Cowbridge lighting Delegated authority has been approved to include this new scheme in the 2025/26 Capital Programme with a budget of £12k to be funded from \$106 money. The scheme will install new lighting columns in a section of Cross Inn, Cowbridge.
- 2.33 Housing Improvement Programme Delegated Authority has been approved to allocate the 2025/26 Capital budget of £25.477m as shown in Table Nine below. Changes following the approval via emergency powers, together with approved slippage are also shown and the resulting total budget is reflected in the final column:

Place

2.34 Placemaking enhancements at Bearfield, Cowbridge – Delegated authority has been approved to include a new scheme using Section 106 money and increase the 2025/26 Capital Programme by £114k. The scheme will undertake Placemaking enhancements at Bearfield, Cowbridge. Various proposals have been suggested for Bearfield in the Cowbridge Placemaking Plan which need to be explored further. Site investigation works are therefore needed in order to develop a masterplan for Bearfield. The Section 106 contribution will be used towards this work as well as the implementation of new and enhanced facilities at the site.

Accounting Standard for IFRS16

- 2.35 The implementation for the accounting standard IFRS16 was 1st April 2024 which deals with the accounting arrangements for leasing. Under the standard, leases that relate to assets in excess of £10k will be accounted for as capital expenditure creating a right of use asset on the Council's balance sheet and will be written down over the life of the lease. A corresponding liability is also created on the Council's balance sheet and is written down over the life of the lease. These accounting adjustments do not hit the bottom line of the accounts; the cash transaction will continue to be the lease payment.
- 2.36 The Council will be carrying out a data refresh on leasing information in September 2025 and February 2026 and therefore leasing figures will be updated in further monitoring reports throughout 2025/26. The Council's total opening lease liability for 2025/26 is £2.922m, with a projected closing liability of £2.704m.
- 2.37 These figures are not included within Appendices 1 and 2 and the monitoring summary tables within the report. The Council with be carrying out a data refresh on leasing information in September 2025 and February 2026 and therefore Leasing figures will be updated in the quarter two monitoring report.

3. How do proposals evidence the Five Ways of Working and contribute to our Well-being Objectives?

- 3.1 The Capital Programme focuses capital investment to deliver the outcomes identified as part of the new Corporate Plan, Vale 2030. Some examples are:
 - Creating Great Places to Live, Work and Visit Contributing as a partner in the Cardiff Capital Region, City Deal will bring economic prosperity to the area. There will be continued investment in environment and regeneration programmes to support economic growth and further investments supported as part of the Non-Treasury Service Investment Strategy. Funding has been secured through the UK Government Levelling Fund. Discussions are ongoing with Partners and UK Government. The Marina element of the project is no longer progressing, but discussions are ongoing with Government and partners to ensure that the other elements of the project can proceed as planned. Investment in housing through the Housing Improvement Programme will maintain the Welsh Housing Quality Standard, consideration of alternative heating measures and new developments.
 - Respecting and Celebrating the Environment The Council supports
 decarbonisation as part the Sustainable Communities for Learning
 Programme, which has seen the first Net Zero Carbon Primary School in
 Wales. A number of decarbonisation schemes were delivered in the 2024/25
 Capital Programme including the installation of air source heat pump at Bro
 Morgannwg, PV panels at 7 Council sites including residential homes, schools
 and Leisure Centres. There is a decarbonisation scheme on the Capital
 Programme totalling £1.297m from 2025/26 to 2029/30 and this this budget
 has been allocated across 6 schemes for installation of LED lighting, PV
 Panels, interface upgrades and air source heat pumps.
 - Giving Everyone a Good start in Life We show our commitment to the
 youngest people in our community by further investment in schools through
 the School Investment Programme. We are committed to working together
 to provide the support children and families need with schemes such as our
 Early Years and Childcare programme. We will continue our work around our
 community focused schools, recognising the value schools bring to the local
 community and ensure that we continue our investment in leisure centre and
 playgrounds.
 - Supporting and Protecting Those who Need Us We will ensure that our residents who need more support are able to access schemes such as the Disabled Facility Grant, Discretionary Adaptions Grant and Enable. Under the Social Services Invest to Save scheme in the 2024/25 Capital Programme, 2 properties have been appropriated from Housing to Social Services to provide accommodation for unaccompanied asylum-seeking children. Works are currently ongoing to ensure these properties are fit for purpose. We work collaboratively with a range of partners to deliver schemes to prevent and tackle poverty such as Tackling Food Poverty and take forward our work to ensure the Vale of Glamorgan is a Country of Sanctuary through schemes within our Housing Improvement Programme.

- Being the best Council We Can Be Consultations are carried out with the community on capital projects. Participate Vale allows the community to have their say and get involved with Council decisions and local issues in the Vale of Glamorgan.
- 3.2 The setting and the monitoring of the Capital programme follows the Five Ways of Working.
 - Looking to the long term The development of the capital programme is a
 means of planning for the future and takes a strategic approach to ensure
 services are sustainable and that investments are affordable over the longer
 term and that future need and demand for services is understood.
 - Taking an integrated approach In setting the capital programme, working with partners is encouraged, as it allows the utilisation of funding from various sources, such as Welsh and UK Government and S106 contributions, to deliver schemes.
 - Involving the population in decisions As part of the annual budget setting
 process there is engagement with residents, customers and partners. Prior to
 the implementation of certain capital schemes, consultation may also take
 place with the public which may in some cases be statutory.
 - Working in a collaborative way It is recognised that more can be achieved, and better services can be provided by collaboration, and it encourages this as a way of working in the future which includes providing funding to work with local communities.
 - Understanding the root cause of issues and preventing them The process
 for setting and monitoring the capital programme is proactive and allows an
 understanding of the financial and operational issues to be considered
 together so that issues can be tackled at the source.

4. Climate Change and Nature Implications

4.1 The Council understands the importance of decarbonisation to help protect and sustain the environment over the long term and in line with its Climate emergency declaration is working and investing in measures to reduce its CO2 emissions. Several projects are included in the 2025/26 Capital Programme which will assist the work the Council is undertaking as part of Project Zero and commitments in the Council's Climate Challenge Plan. More detail can be found in the Section 6 of the Capital Strategy. All schemes progressed as part of the Capital Programme proposals set out the decarbonisation considerations that will be considered as part of progressing the bids.
