## 1.0 What is this report about?

### **3.0 What is the background to this report?**

- 3.1 Historically, the Council has appointed / nominated representatives to sit on a large number of Outside Bodies / Joint Committees.
- 3.2 It being noted that the Council's representative on the South East Wales Corporate Joint Committee is the Executive Leader and Cabinet Member for Performance and Resources, with the Deputy Leader and Cabinet Member for Sustainable Places as substitute, and for the South East Wales Corporate Joint Scrutiny Committee the representative previously approved by Full Council is the Chair of the Place Scrutiny Committee and a nominated deputy appointed by the Place Scrutiny Committee.

### **4.0 What issues are there to be considered?**

- 4.1 Cabinet at its meeting of 9th June 2022 resolved that all such appointments to Outside Bodies / Joint Committees should run for the life of the Council, i.e., until the local government elections in 2027 (Minute No. C6 refers) and was subject to the agreement of the relevant body to which Members have been appointed.
- 4.2 Attached at Appendix A are proposed changes to the membership of a number of Outside Bodies / Joint Committees which have been proposed since the last report was considered by Cabinet on 22nd May 2025.

### **5.0 How has evidence been used to inform the report, including the views of others?**

- 5.1 Officers have liaised with Members and Group Leaders as appropriate to determine nominations where changes to the previous appointments / nominations to represent the Council on Outside Bodies / Joint Committees was required, and is illustrated in Appendix A.
