What can an Order do?

- Purpose is to provide a proportionate and robust response to alcohol related anti- social behaviour (ASB)
- Effective way of managing land to prevent any ASB escalating by providing additional powers to issue warnings seize and confiscate alcohol, stop alcohol consumption.

If a person (s)

- Continues to drink alcohol when required to stop by an Authorised Officer and/or
- Does not surrender any alcohol in his or her possession when required to do so by an Authorised Officer and/or
- Refuses to hand over any containers (sealed or unsealed) which are believed to contain alcohol, when required to do so

an Authorised Officer can confiscate and issue a Fixed Penalty Notice.

- Protection of land to protect the majority of law abiding citizens
- Legal Test required before Order can be made

Renewal and New Orders for Consultation

Report sought approval to vary the existing 2017 Alcohol Public Space Protection orders in Penarth, Barry, Rhoose, Llantwit Major and Cowbridge due to expire October 2020.

Following issues over Summer 2020, added to these, for consultation, were areas where there had been issues with alcohol including: Cosmeston Country Park, Porthkerry Country Park, Penarth Pier and Esplanade, Ogmere Beach area, Llantwit Major Beach and Rhoose Point.
