**HOUSING**

I would like to ask the Council why it feels they should be housing homeless applicants before anyone else on the housing list? Whilst I fully understand the Council legal requirement to help house those who are homeless, I question where that leaves others who are in desperate need of suitable housing? How someone can be gold plus for in excess of two years, can be ignored when a family who is homeless for less than two months then takes priority. I would like to ask the Council what data has been collected to assess the impact this policy has on other applicants and there circumstances.

What are the Homes4U team doing to house others for whom they have statutory responsibility?
