LICENSE FOR ROMILLYS CAFE SHOP, 1-2 BRON Y MOR, THE KNAP, BARRY.

I wish to object to the alcohol license and extension to the operating hours of the above premises on the grounds of public nuisance. Could you please take the following points into account when considering the application;

- Previous applications have limited the opening hours of the premises from 8.30 a.m. to 10 p.m. each day to reflect its location in a residential area, [1997/00635/FUL]. It would be appreciated if both its operating hours and alcohol license could be limited to 10pm, due to its close proximity to houses.
- The premises has a large outdoor seating area. I am concerned about the noise that will be generated from this area if it is allowed to operate until 11pm each night. I am in particular concerned about the noise generated from the seating area at the rear of the property. Noise could be heard from this area on a previous summer evening event at the premises which involved "bring your own drinks". If a licence is now given to extend the operating hours of the premises I am concerned about the noise that this would create seven days a week in a residential area. In light of this could I please ask that seats to the rear of the premise are removed by 9pm each night. In recent years a previous application for the Bridge Cafe also had this restriction included as part of their operating restrictions.
- I understand that the Highways Department have plans to close the entrance of the Bron Y Mor Car Park at night, which is next to Romillys. If the car park is closed customers of the premises will be forced to park in Bron Y Mor. I am concerned about the noise and disruption from customers leaving the premises late at night.
