### ANNEX 2 - CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

CCTV is to operate at all times when the premises are open to the public.

Microphone recording system is to operate at all times when the premises are open to the public.

1. A 'closed sign' shall be displayed at the entrance at the terminal hour specified on the licence.

### Capacity and Safe Condition of Premises

2. No overcrowding in any part of the premises which would interfere with the safety of the public shall be permitted.

### Light Pollution

3. Flashing or bright lights on or outside the licensed premise shall not cause a nuisance to nearby properties.

### Noise and Vibration

4. Noise shall not be permitted to emanate from the premises so as to cause a nuisance to the occupiers of nearby properties.
5. All reasonably practicable steps shall be taken to prevent a nuisance at any neighbouring properties, during and outside the hours of operation. Non essential extraction systems, heating and refrigeration system shall be turned off when not required.
6. All reasonably practicable steps shall be taken to prevent a noise nuisance at any neighbouring properties as public and staff leave and use the premise.
7. Clearly legible notices shall be displayed at all exits from the premise requesting public and staff to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premise and area quietly.
8. All refuse and bottles shall be disposed of in bins quietly so as not to disturb neighbours or local residents.
9. Appropriate measures will be taken to limit noise from deliveries, collections and servicing and that these will prevent avoidable noise disturbance to noise sensitive properties.
10. The licence holder shall request that collections and operational servicing are carried out reasonable hours such as after 0800hrs and not after 1900hrs, except where access at other times in unavoidable and specific procedures are in place to limit disturbance.
11. Guidance shall be given to drivers to switch off engines during deliveries, collections and

servicing, and to minimise other noise caused by their activities.

**Odour/Noxious Smells**

12. The premises shall be properly ventilated and extraction systems shall be constructed and operated so as to prevent noxious smells from causing a nuisance to nearby properties.

13. Odour shall not emanate from waste areas, bins shall be sealed and be of sufficient size to hold all waste generated by the business. Bins shall also be cleanable and be emptied and cleaned on a regular basis.

**Cleansing of Flues, Ventilation, Ducting and Shafts**

14. Ventilation ducting and shafts generally shall be maintained in a clean condition.

15. Grease filters in extract ventilation hoods in kitchens and serveries shall be regularly cleaned e.g. weekly.

**Take Aways - Cleansing**

16. Where the premises provide food for consumption off the premises, the public area immediately surrounding the premises shall be cleared of waste food, food containers, wrapping etc. regularly during the stated operating hours and at the end of trading on each day. Such refuse shall be placed in a container designed for the storage and disposal of refuse and waste foods which shall be constructed, maintained and located so that access to it by vermin and unauthorized persons is prevented and arrangements shall be made for the regular lawful disposal of their contents.

17. The pavement from the building line to the kerb edge immediately outside the premises, including the gutter/channel at its junction with the kerb edge, shall be kept clean as well as free from litter at all material times to the satisfaction of the Licensing Authority.
