

Additional Information submitted by Representation 1

I am writing as the Sully Sports & Social club Secretary and following on from your recent email objection sent to the council on 20th April. That has been sent on to us as required and we wanted to take the opportunity of reaching out to you to try and address your apparent concerns.

The reason behind our application was to facilitate a “one off” proposed event, that being a country music celebration. We have no intention whatsoever of planning to run such events “every Saturday throughout the year”. The event is planned as an attempt to engage with our local community in a positive way. It is primarily designed to appeal to families and offer an occasion which will benefit the community.

We are always conscious that any event which attempts to reach out to a larger audience also has the possibility of causing some nuisance to our more proximate neighbours. We wish to address any concerns in that regard. Please do not hesitate to let us know if we can provide you with more detail. The noise levels would be monitored throughout the event, and the event is organised in a way whereby noise pollution is minimised. Traffic management and general disruption to the community have been at the forefront of the plans and we can share our control measure plans with you if that would help to further address concerns.

We want the club to remain and offer a beneficial facility for the community, but we cannot achieve that without organising some events which we hope will generate much needed income. The alternative is for the club to close and we fear that as well as then losing the benefits we deliver to the community, alternative uses of the grounds are likely to be far less attractive for the community and our neighbours.

I hope that you may be to some extent reassured by this contact and would hope that you may be willing to withdraw your objection by writing to the council. Of course, we perfectly respect your views otherwise. If you require additional information, please do not hesitate to respond to this email and we will assist where we can.

Finally, whilst I note your concerns about the notification of application around the site, we have needed to follow “to the letter” the statutory requirements notified to us by the council.

Dear (Representation 2),

Thank you for taking the trouble to come back to us. That is very much appreciated. I take on board your comment about communication with local residents, but it is always very difficult to know who wants to hear from us, when and how to best communicate. We try and do so with social media and suchlike and are always happy to respond directly to concerns when raised, as with yourself in this case. Otherwise, we need to follow notification requirements of the relevant regulatory body (in this case the council) with the attaching of notices to our premises as occurred in respect of this application. If you do have any suggestions on better methods of communication, we are certainly willing to consider those.

We have been advised that the request submitted is in the correct form for what is required but we have indicated to the council (who have been copied in to this reply) that we are willing for a condition to be attached to the permission (were that to be granted) that the extension can be limited to two occasions in any one year. I hope that may address your concerns and, if so, we would certainly very much appreciate your confirmation in that regard.
