79 GRANT OF A HACKNEY CARRIAGE AND PRIVATE HIRE DRIVER'S LICENCE (DEH) (EXEMPT INFORMATION – PARAGRAPHS 12, 13 AND 14) –

The report was presented by the Senior Licensing Officer. The Applicant attended the meeting and provided representations in support of their application. The Applicant was asked to elaborate on details contained in the report, their application, their supplemental information, and to provide information as to why they found that the Committee should depart from its adopted guidelines on determining the suitability of applicants for hackney carriage and private hire vehicle driver's licences.

Having fully considered the matter, Committee subsequently:

RESOLVED – T H A T having regard to the report, the Guidelines adopted by the Public Protection Licensing Committee and the representations made by the Applicant, Members determined that the Applicant was not a fit and proper person to hold a hackney carriage and private hire vehicle driver's licence.

Reason for decision

Members found that there was insufficient information provided to them to constitute grounds for departing from the adopted guidelines on determining the suitability of applicants.
