1. ROWIP Projects 2016-17

1.1 The project comprises a number of programme actions aiming to assist in the delivery of ROWIP Objectives.

VG1	Summerhouse Point	Dedication of rights at Summerhouse	Approval to proceed with an order has been granted by committee. Instructions are with legal services regarding compensation, due imminently.
VG2	Countywide	Adopt a path coordination of works	Instructions for maintenance issues on adopt a path routes have been issued for Six Village Walk; Warlow Walk; Bonvilston Circular; In and about Welsh St Donats; Castle Court and Wells
VG3	Countywide	Definitive Map anomalies – resolve long standing issues by order	Commencement of project delayed whilst staffing confirmed. Likely to be rescheduled for 2017/18
VG4	30km of priority routes	Vegetation clearance	Annual clearance cuts complete

1.2 VG1 provides for the dedication of public footpath rights along a track between boverton mill and summerhouse point. The grant allocation reflects anticipated compensation figures in addition to legal costs.

- 1.3 VG2 will support the coordination and resolution of maintenance issues on promoted routes that are part of the Adopt a Path scheme.
- 1.4 VG3 will begin to address long standing issues identified during the quality assurance of the Definitive Map process. This is likely to be through a mix of orders, negotiations and/or enforcement where appropriate.
- 1.5 VG4 will support the annual clearance of inland routes.
