## 1. Workshops

We're planning a series of workshops to help inform our review of the Vale of Glamorgan's Rights of Way Improvement Plan (ROWIP).

It's now 10 years since we first published our ROWIP, and at this stage, we have a statutory obligation to carry out this review, and to republish our ROWIP.

We would like to hear from a wide variety of organisations and individuals who use or have an interest in our county's rights of way. As we did in 2007, we want to consider how well our local rights of way meet people's needs now and for the future, and what the opportunities are for improvements, e.g. to provide recreation, or to contribute to well-being.
