Constituency Activity and Achievements

I continue to deal with numerous Constituency problems on a wide variety of issues. Housing, litter, rubbish dumping, traffic safety, schools, dog fouling, potholes road surfacing are just some of the problems that I have handled. Illegal rubbish dumping, black bags and dog fouling are still some of the most reported problems in the area. Some issues that I deal with are of a personal and sensitive nature and, therefore, cannot be dealt with in this report.

The volume of traffic on the roads in certain areas in the Vale has become very noticeable in recent years and I was Chair of the Task and Finish Group that looked into Traffic Management looking at ways to try and alleviate this and also offer ways to look at sustainable travel. This did entail a lot of work for myself and the small group that looked into this.

The three Cadoc Councillors hold surgeries, but the majority of people contact us directly by e-mail, by telephone or by knocking on our door, or when we are out and about, including when we are shopping in Cadoc and elsewhere.

We carry out an annual pothole/road surface survey and pass this on to our Highways Department for dealing with, as well as keeping an eye on the roads and rubbish dumping when we drive through Cadoc on a daily basis.

There have also been some disruption caused to residents as a consequence of the Coldbrook Flood Alleviation Scheme and where this has happened we have done our best to alleviate this, but a scheme of this magnitude does bring with it some disruption and problems to local residents in Cadoc
